

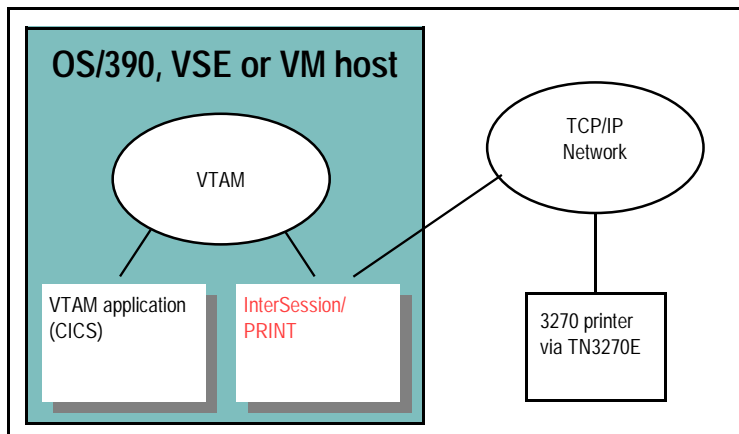
# InterSession/PRINT

## TN3270E print for OS/390, VSE and VM

While more and more 3270 traffic has moved away from SNA to TCPIP most 3270 printers are still attached via SNA, Coax or through gateway boxes.

**InterSession/PRINT** is a mainframe based gateway that will allow your applications to print TN3270E attached printers.

**InterSession/PRINT** starts virtual VTAM printers the printing VTAM applications can use. The data sent to the virtual printers is relayed to the TN3270E attached printers. The TN3270E attached printers are connected to InterSession/PRINT via TCPIP and this eliminates the need for SNA connectivity to all 3270 printers in the network. This also allows for easy printer access for mobile workstations.

### System Requirements on VSE

A working IBM-supported release of VSE with VTAM and TCP/IP for VSE (IBM or Connectivity Systems).

### System Requirements on VM

A working IBM-supported release of VM with GCS and VTAM and IBM TCPIP for VM.

### System Requirements on OS/390

A working IBM-supported release of MVS or OS/390 with VTAM and either IBM TCPIP 3.1 or higher, or TCPAccess 3.1 or higher.
